Dear Parent,

I just wanted to update you with a few bits before the end of term.

We will be providing hot school meals in September and the usual booking system for booking hot lunches will be in place. We will email the new menu to you on Monday 20th July which will be live for bookings on Tuesday 21st July.

A reminder about drop off and pick up times in September - this time with Friday times included. We will be staggering the start and end of the day to ease the number of parents and children coming in and out of school at the same time. Please see times per class below. If you have more than 1 child at school, please drop all siblings at the **earliest time** you have been given and siblings can line up and wait for their class time slot on the playground. All teachers will be on the playground ready to greet the children and walk them to their classrooms. All classes will have an allocated space to line up on the playground.

Please ensure you stick to your allocated time and are on time to maintain as much social distancing as possible. Older children can be dropped off at the back gate and walk in to the playground on their own. We ask that only 1 parent of younger children bring in their child. Any toddler siblings must remain with their parent/carer and not be allowed to run around the playground.

There is a one-way system in place that must be followed. Everyone is expected to come in via the back gate and leave by the main gate. Where possible please walk or cycle to school. **As always, no parking is allowed in the school staff car park.**
