Behaviour Policy - Child Friendly Version July 2020

At Haydon Wick we want every member of the school community to feel valued and respected.



We want every person to be treated fairly and well.

We all care for each other and respect each other.



Each class has golden rules that all children and adults follow.



We praise and reward children for following the rules and showing good behaviour.



If someone breaks the rules the adults in school will use a sanction.

- You might have to sit on your own for a little while and have some time to think and calm down.
- If you don't try your best you might have to redo your task.
- You might have to miss a bit of playtime.



- If someone is very mean or hurts or bullies another child, then the class teacher will tell your parents and the adults will have a meeting to decide how to stop it from happening again.

Children have the right to feel safe in school so we do not tolerate any bullying.

All teachers will talk to you about your rights in school; the things you can always expect. They will also talk about your responsibilities; the things you should always try to do.

Coronavirus

We have a few more rules to follow to keep us safe at the moment.

Staying in bubbles – Each class will become a bubble. We need to stay in our bubbles so we don't mix with too many children.




Coming to school and going home – Each bubble will have their own time to get to school and to go home.

This is so there aren't lots of people on the playground at the same time. Your teachers will collect your class from the playground in the morning and take you to go to meet your parents on the playground again at home time.

Playtimes and lunchtimes – Each bubble will have their own time for playtime and lunchtime too. We will only be able to play with children from our bubble. We need to try to remember to stay safe at playtimes.

We can't use equipment as it might not be clean and we need to try to remember to keep a safe distance from each other. All the adults do understand that you might forget to do this. They will not be cross; they will just give you reminders.




Using the toilet - Each bubble will have their **own** toilet and your teacher will tell you which one your class uses. Children can only go if they ask first and can only go 1 at a time.

Good Hygiene - If you have to wipe or blow your nose, use a tissue and put it in the bin straight away.

If you have to cough or sneeze, do it into the inside corner of your elbow, not on to your hand.



Washing our hands – We will all have to wash our hands all through the day. We will wash our hands as soon as we get to school and before and after each play. Your teachers might ask you to wash your hands more for another reason too. We need to wash our hands for 20 seconds so we know it is done properly.



Did you know that viruses are killed by soap? So if you wash your hands really carefully and for long enough, you won't have any coronavirus germs on your hands. You can sing a song while you wash your hands to make sure you are washing them for long enough – long enough to sing Happy Birthday twice!

Unsafe Behaviours

If anyone behaves in an unsafe way, the adults will be very upset. Children who are unsafe will need to talk to their teacher and Mrs Gale and might get sent home. It is very important that we all make sure we are only using safe behaviours.

Spitting	Blowing raspberries at people	Sneezing or coughing in someone's face on purpose	Refusing to wash hands

Remember all the grown-ups at school are there to help you!

If you feel worried or sad or scared, then you can tell any of the adults in school and we will try our best to help you feel better.

We will all try to stay safe and happy in school and make sure everyone feels good!
