John Moore Museum - Tewkesbury.

As part of our topic work on 'The Tudors' and on 'The Great Fire of London' we would like to visit the John Moore Museum in Tewkesbury. The children will take part in three exciting workshops related to Tudor and Stuart times, some led by costumed re-enactors. They will visit a real house from that time, in company with its costumed owner who will tell them about the furnishings and objects in the house. They will also have a chance to play with Tudor and Stuart toys and games. For many, the highlight will be the visit to the barber - surgeon to find out what it was like to be ill at that time.
