I hope you had a good Easter holiday and long weekend. The children have settled back into their learning. We have a busy few weeks for the rest of this term with SAT's for year 2 and 6 and all pupils will be undertaking assessments in Maths and English this term.

200 mile Bike Challenge

The Principal at The Peak Academy has organised a 200-mile bike ride to raise money for The Shamrock School in Nepal. The White Horse Federation has supported this school with sponsorship for many years. All schools within TWHF are taking part in this fundraising.

This is not going to be an easy challenge as the full distance is over 200 miles in total over 3 days. The team will visit every school in the TWHF family. The aim is to connect all the schools through a physical challenge collecting all the schools 'Values' flags starting in Devizes 21st June and finishing on Friday 23rd June at Peak.

Two members of our staff are part of the team, Mr Neil Greenwood and Mrs Amanda Heard. At Haydon Wick, we want to get all our pupils involved in this fundraising and to gain sponsorship to complete the 200 miles in school together. We hope to complete our challenge partly on a turbo bike where Years 4/5/6 will complete a mile each and the rest of our pupils will complete a mile round the track on either a bike or a scooter on a designated day in the week beginning 19th June. The school council are also organising a competition for pupils to take part in if they so wish. More details will follow.
