Tigers class completed some terrific learning in Term 3. We began by exploring the plays of William Shakespeare, but focussing on Macbeth. The original tragedy – a hero turning evil!

We used this story as our inspiration to write a narrative version of the play. We included some excellent description and characterisation – especially of the fascinating characters: the weird sisters. We also used Macbeth as inspiration to create a non-fiction piece of writing. We imagined that after the story ended Macbeth's castle was put up for sale, therefore we wrote an estate agent advert with subtle links to the story.

Our history topic revolved around William Shakespeare. We studied his life and the plays he wrote and the impact he has had on modern language and storytelling. We create a biography detailing the major events in his life.

We continued to learn new sports and activities in PE (dance and basketball) and in science we studied the biology of our circulatory and digestive systems. Finishing with a brilliant experiment that investigated the effects of static exercise.
