Write an information text about an animal of your choice. Include information about their habitat and food.

Write a poem about an animal whose habitat is in another country.

Use your imagination to invent a completely new animal. Write an instruction leaflet explaining how to look after it.

Write a letter to Mrs Gale persuading her to raise money for an endangered animal. Research your chosen animal and include factual information.

Write a newspaper report about the destruction of the rainforests. Include information about the animals whose habitat is disappearing.

Find out where a variety of plants/ animals come from and mark them on a map.

Choose a minimum of 3 animals. Label pictures with information about how they are suited to their habitats.

Research an animal that you don't know much about.

Write 10 Maths problems using your research and knowledge of animals and their habitats.

Choose an animal and research its growth from birth to adult. Use this information to draw a graph.

Choose a pet you don't own. Find out how much it would cost to feed for one day. Use this information to work out how much for a week, month, year, and the average lifetime.

Go outside and study your garden / local park. What did you find living there?

Research and present your findings about a famous animal / animals from history (use a format of your choice).

Make 10 Top Trump cards about animals from 10 different countries.

Find out more about 3 animals living in another country and present this information in a format of your choice.

Using a world map, show where the habitats of at least 10 different animals are located.

Find out about the history of zoos and the changes that have taken place to make sure that animals are well treated. Present this information in a format of your choice.

Use clay/paper mache to make models of animals.

Design an enclosure in a wildlife reserve for an animal of your choice.

Paint or sketch a picture of an animal of your choice, in its habitat.

Create a montage of images showing animals and their habitats from a particular country.

Design and make an animal mask.

Create a piece of art work based on an animal or plant.

Discover a new plant and make a fact file about it.

Grow your own plant and keep a diary.

Find out what plants are used for.
