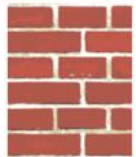

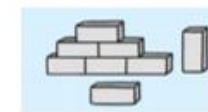

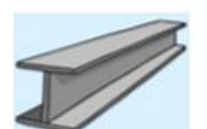
Manmade materials are materials which have been produced by humans.

Key Vocabulary

Properties	What a material feels like, looks like and behaves like.
Hard	Solid and firm, not easily broken or bent.
Soft	Easy to mould, press, cut or fold.
Smooth	No roughness, lumps or bumps - an even surface.
Rough	Uneven to touch and not smooth.
Bendy	Can be bent - soft or flexible.
Stiff	Does not bend or stretch easily.
Shiny	Smooth and reflecting light.
Dull	Doesn't reflect light.
Waterproof	Does not let water in or through it.
Absorbent	Can soak up water.
